The cor. of secs. 1, 6, 7 and 12, monumented with a trapstone, 28X16X10 ins., firmly set in a mound of stone, plainly mkd. with 5 notches on S. edge and 6 notches on E. edge. This corner will now refer to secs. 6 and 7 only.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 14 ins. in the ground to solid rock and in a mound of stone, 4 ft. base to top, with brass cap mkd.

Over rolling land, through scattered timber and undergrowth.

The E ¼ sec. cor. of sec. 1, T. 40 N., R. 18 E., monumented with an iron post, 2½ ins. diam., firmly set and exposed 4 ins. above the ground with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the dependent resurvey of a portion of the subdivisional lines of T. 40 N., R. 18 E., executed concurrently under this same Group.
