TOWNSHIP 38 NORTH, RANGE 51 EAST, MDM, NEVADA CHAINS **GENERAL DESCRIPTION** The land resurveyed between Tps. 37 and 38 N., Rs. 51 E. and the portion of the west boundary of T. 38 N., R. 51 E., is about 6,500 ft. to 7,700 ft. above sea level and is rolling mountainous land to mountainous land. The soil is sandy clay loam along the creek bottoms and rocky on the high elevations. The land is covered with sagebrush, buckbrush and native grass except along the creek bottoms which is covered with choke cherry and scattered aspen. Williams Canyon Creek crosses the south bdy. of section 33, and Beaver Creek crosses the south bdy. of section 32, both creeks drain ESE. Principal users of the area are cattle ranchers. There was some mineral formations noted in sec. 36.
