TOWNSHIP 38 NORTH, RANGE 52 EAST, MDM, NEVADA CHAINS GENERAL DESCRIPTION The land resurveyed between Tps. 37 and 38 N., Rs. 52 E., is about 5,800 to 7,600 ft. above sea level and is rolling to mountainous land. The soil is sandy clay loam along the bottom land and rocky on the higher elevations. The land is covered with sagebrush, buckbrush and native grass except along the creek bottom which is covered with meadow grass and chokecherry. There is a graded road crossing irregularly from east to west, entering in sec. 35 and leaving in sec. 31. Lake Creek crosses the south bdy. of sec. 31, T. 38 N., R. 52 E. draining ESE. and ENE. Principal users of the area are cattle ranchers. There was some mineral formations noted in sec. 6, T. 37 N., R. 52 E.
