The elevation varies from 5,300 to 7,400 feet above sea level. The soil varies from sandy clay loam in the lower elevations and rocky in the higher elevations. The vegetation consists of buckbrush, chokecherry, sagebrush, crested wheatgrass and other sparse native grass.</p> <p>The main ridge of the Tuscarora Mountains is located in the eastern portion of the township and bears N. and S. The main drainage, Rodeo Creek, enters the township in section 32 and exits in section 19.</p> <p>Mining operations are situated in sections 30 and 31, the principal users of the township are cattlemen. There is no timber of consequence in the township.</p> <hr/> |
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
