CHAINS

Set a steel fence post, $5\frac{1}{2}$ ft. long, alongside the aluminum post.

From this corner, the standard cor. of T. 36 N., R. 51 E., hereinbefore described, bears S. 89° 20' W., 16.88 chs. dist.

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The area resurveyed within Township 35 North, Range 51 East, is mountainous land. The elevation ranges from about 6,000 to 6,800 ft. above sea level. The vegetation consists of sagebrush, buckbrush, chokecherry and other sparse native grass. There are scattered stands of cottonwood trees along Cottonwood Creek which crosses the township in a northeastern course.

No mineral formations of consequence were noted during the survey.
