<p>CHAINS</p> <p>40.10</p>	<p>S. 89° 58' W., beginning new measurement.</p> <p>Over mountainous land.</p> <p>The cor. of secs. 2 and 11.</p> <hr/> <p>GENERAL DESCRIPTION</p> <p>The area resurveyed within Township 39 North, Range 18 East, ranges from about 7,000 to 7,900 ft. above sea level and is mountainous. The soil varies from sandy clay to gravelly and rocky. The vegetation consists of rabbitbrush, sagebrush, buckbrush and bunchgrass.</p> <p>There are scattered juniper, mahogany and aspen on the higher elevations of little commercial value.</p> <p>Principal users of the area are cattlemen and access into the township is provided by numerous unimproved trail roads.</p> <p>No mineral formations of consequence were noted during the survey.</p> <hr/>
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
