The $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 13 and 18, monumented with an
iron post, 1 in. diam., firmly set showing 8 ins. above
ground, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field
notes of the survey of T. 22 N., R. 48 E., executed
under Group No. 36.

iron post, 3 ins. diam., firmly set showing 8 ins.
above ground, with brass cap mkd. as described in the
field notes of the dependent resurvey of T. 22 N., R.
48 E., executed under Group No. 36. Hereafter this
cor. will refer to secs. 7 and 18 only.
