CHAINS	<p>N. 1° 17' W., beginning new measurement.</p> <p>Over mountainous land.</p> <p>37.80 Bluff, bears WNW. and ESE.</p> <p>40.12 The cor. of secs. 1, 6, 7 and 12, monumented with the decayed remains of a wooden post, loosely set in a mound of earth.</p> <p>At the corner point</p> <p>Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 26 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">T44N R18E R19E S 1 S 6 S 12 S 7</p> <p style="text-align: center;">1985</p> <p>Deposit the decayed remains of the original wooden post, alongside the iron post, and raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 1½ ft. high, W. of corner.</p>
40.19	<p>N. 1° 06' W., bet. secs. 1 and 6.</p> <p>Over rolling mountainous land, covered with scattered juniper, sagebrush and native grass.</p> <p>Point for the ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 6, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.</p> <p>Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 18 ins. in the ground to solid rock and in a mound of stone, 4½ ft. base to top, with brass cap mkd.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">T44N R18E R19E ¼ S 1 S 6</p> <p style="text-align: center;">1985</p>
44.30	<p>Trail road, bears NW. and SE.</p>
50.10	<p>Enter nearly level land, covered with native grass.</p>
80.38	<p>The cor. of Tps. 44 and 45 N., Rs. 18 and 19 E., monumented with a wooden post, 48 ins. long, 4 ins. square, loosely set in a mound of earth, with illegible scribe marks visible.</p> <p>At the corner point</p> <p>Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 25 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.</p>
