This cor. now refers to sec. 25 only.</p> <p>Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">T44N R19E <math>\frac{1}{4}</math> S 25 1985</p> <p>Set a steel fence post, 5½ ft. long, alongside the iron post.</p> <p>41.10 The N <math>\frac{1}{4}</math> sec. cor. of sec. 36, hereinafter described.</p> <p>54.70 Leave dry lake bottom; enter gently rolling land, covered with scattered sagebrush, rabbitbrush and native grass.</p> <p>67.90 Wash, 10 lks. wide, 1 ft. deep, drains NE.</p> <p>79.08 The cor. of secs. 25, 26, 35 and 36, monumented with the decayed remains of a wooden post, loosely set in a mound of earth.
