T. 20 S., R. 59 E., MDM, NEVADA

CHAINS
56.28

Angle Point No. 2, established at a point 50 ft. (southerly) 90° to the spur, of elevation point 3950 as shown on U.S.G.S. 7½' Quadrangle map "LaMadre Mtn.," located in the SE. ¼ of sec. 32.

Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., on solid rock over a cross (X), in a mound of stone, 4 ft. base to top, with brass cap mkd.

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

Township 20 South, Range 59 East, is situated about 10 miles west of Las Vegas, Nevada. The main access into the area is via Charleston Boulevard. There are numerous unimproved jeep trails throughout the township. The area surveyed and resurveyed varies from mountainous in the western portion to rolling in the eastern portion. The elevation ranges from about 3,600 to 7,000 ft. above sea level. The soil varies from rocky in the higher elevations to sandy and gravelly in the lower elevations. The vegetation consists of creosote and chaparral brush, barrel, yucca, Cholla and prickly pear cactus, scattered Joshua trees and stands of mesquite trees along the washes. There is juniper, pine and scrub oak in the higher elevations.
