

TOWNSHIP 21 SOUTH, RANGE 59 EAST, MDM, NEVADA

<div>CHAINS</div>	<div>GENERAL DESCRIPTION</div> <div>Township 21 South, Range 59 East, is situated about 10 miles west from downtown Las Vegas, Nevada. The main access into the area is via Charleston Boulevard. There are numerous unimproved jeep trails throughout the township. The area surveyed and resurveyed varies from mountainous in the western portion to rolling in the eastern portion. The elevation ranges from about 2,600 to 5,000 ft. above sea level. The soil varies from rocky in the higher elevations to sandy and gravelly in the lower elevations. The vegetation consists of creosote and chaparral brush; barrel, yucca, cholla and prickly pear cactus; scattered Joshua trees and stands of mesquite trees along Red Rock Wash. The township is drained by Red Rock Wash, which enters the township in section 18 drains northeast changing to southeast in section 3 and exits in section 13.</div>
