

DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF THE $W\frac{1}{2}SW\frac{1}{4}NW\frac{1}{4}$ OF SECTION 36,
IDENTICAL WITH INDIAN ALLOTMENT NO. 106,

T. 13 N., R. 28 E., MDM, NEVADA

CHAINS

- 16.713 Center line Southern Pacific Railroad track, on bridge, parallels right-of-way.
- 16.80 Right bank Walker River, course SW.
- 18.564 Intersect Southern Pacific Railroad right-of-way, bears N. $54^{\circ} 37.9'$ W. and S. $54^{\circ} 37.9'$ E.
- 19.841 The C-W-NW $1/64$ sec. cor. of sec. 36, monumented with an iron post, 2 ins. diam., firmly set flush with surface of the ground, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the dependent resurvey of T. 13 N., R. 28 E., executed under Group No. 66. Remark the brass cap to read:

S. $89^{\circ} 21.5'$ W., on the E. and W. center line of the $NW\frac{1}{4}$ of sec. 36.

Over nearly level land.

- 1.778 Intersect Southern Pacific Railroad right-of-way, bears N. $54^{\circ} 37.9'$ W. and S. $54^{\circ} 37.9'$ E.
- 4.355 Center line Southern Pacific Railroad track, parallels right-of-way.
- 6.932 Intersect Southern Pacific Railroad right-of-way, bears N. $54^{\circ} 37.9'$ W. and S. $54^{\circ} 37.9'$ E.
- 9.819 The N $1/16$ sec. cor. of secs. 35 and 36.

SUBDIVISION OF SECTION 21,
T. 13 N., R. 28 E., MOUNT DIABLO MERIDIAN, NEVADA

From the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 21 and 28.

N. $0^{\circ} 09.3'$ W., on the N. and S. center line of sec. 21.

Over gently rolling land, covered with scattered sagebrush, shadscale and native grass.

- 20.009 Point for the C-S $1/16$ sec. cor. of sec. 21.
- Set an aluminum post, 30 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, and in a collar of stone, with aluminum cap mkd.
