The soil is sandy clay loam and the vegetation consists mostly of scattered sagebrush and native grass, with cottonwood trees along the Walker River.</p> <p>Access is gained via U.S. Highways Nos. 95 and Alt. 95 which join just south of Schurz. The Southern Pacific Railroad traverses this area in a northwest-southeast direction. There are many access roads, power lines, and irrigation ditches in the area.</p> <hr/>
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
