39.640	The cor. of secs. 5, 6, 31 and 32, on the N. bdy. of the Tp.

	From the ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 5 and 8. N. 0° 13.6' W., on the N. and S. center line of sec. 5. Over gently rolling land, covered with scattered sagebrush and rabbitbrush.
3.594	Intersect Southern Pacific Railroad right-of-way, bears N. 59° 21.7' W. and S. 59° 21.7' E.
4.70	Irrigation ditch, 20 lks. wide, 4 ft. deep, course ESE.
5.360	Center line Southern Pacific Railroad track, parallels right-of-way.
7.125	Intersect Southern Pacific Railroad right-of-way, bears N. 59° 21.7' W. and S. 59° 21.7' E.
20.034	Point for the C-S 1/16 sec. cor. of sec. 5. Set an aluminum post, 30 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 26 ins. in the ground, with aluminum cap mkd. C S 1/16 S 5 C 1986 Set a wooden post, 2X4 ins., 4 ft. long, alongside the aluminum post.
