Reestablishment of the Survey Executed by
U.S. Deputy Surveyors H. Thurtell and W. Kearney,
in 1909.

The cor. of secs. 32 and 33, on the S. bdy. of the Tp.,
monumented with an aluminum post, 2½ ins. diam., firmly
set in a mound of stone, with aluminum cap mkd. as
described in the field notes of the dependent resurvey
of T. 19 N., R. 44 E., executed under Group No. 573.

N. 88° 52' W., along the S. bdy. of sec. 32.

Over rolling mountainous land, covered with scattered
sagebrush.

The cor. of secs. 4 and 5, T. 18 N., R. 44 E.,
monumented with a lava stone, 18X8X8 ins., firmly set
10 ins. in the ground and plainly mkd. with 4 notches
on E. edge and 2 notches on W. edge, with a mound of
stone S.

At the corner point

Set an aluminum post, 30 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 14
ins. in the ground to solid rock and in a mound of
stone, 3 ft. base to top, with aluminum cap mkd.

Deposit the original cornerstone and set a steel fence
post alongside the aluminum post.

stone, 16X10X10 ins., firmly set 12 ins. in the ground
and plainly mkd. ¼ on N. face, with a mound of stone N.

ins. in the ground to solid rock and in a mound of
stone, 3 ft. base to top, with aluminum cap mkd.
