2.50	Ravine, drains NW.
39.19	The $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 7 and 12, monumented with a trapstone, 40X12X11 ins., firmly set in a mound of stone and plainly mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ on W. face.
	At the corner point
	Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., on solid rock over a cross (X), in a mound of stone, 4 ft. base to top, with brass cap mkd.
