CHAINS	<p>From this same corner, the closing cor. of Tps. 37 and 38 N., Rs. 68 E., monumented with a granite stone, 15X12X9 ins., plainly mkd. with 6 grooves on N., S. and W. faces and CC on W. face, firmly set 6 ins. in the ground at the corner of fences, bears N. 88° 35' E., 0.46 chs. dist., from which fences, bear W. and S. This point now becomes an amended monument. Over mountainous land, covered with medium sagebrush, scattered pinon pine, juniper, Brigham tea, cacti and native grass.</p> <p>4.50 Trail road, bears NW. and SE.</p> <p>15.50 Spur, slopes W.</p> <p>19.00 Trail road, bears NNE. and SSW.</p> <p>27.30 Spur, slopes E.</p> <p>39.11 Point for the <math>\frac{1}{4}</math> sec. cor. of secs. 35 and 36, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.</p> <p>Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., on solid rock over a cross (X), in a mound of stone, 5 ft. base to top, with brass cap mkd.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">T38N R68E <math>\frac{1}{4}</math> S 35 S 36  1986</p> <p>Set a steel fence post, 5½ ft. long, alongside the stainless steel post.</p> <p>42.00 Trail road, bears NNW. and SSE.</p>
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
