<p>CHAINS</p> <p>41.45</p>	<p>N. 0° 53' E., beginning new measurement.</p> <p>Over nearly level land.</p> <p>Point for the cor. of secs. 1, 2, 11 and 12, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.</p> <p>Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">T38N R68E S 21 S 1 S 11 S 12</p> <p style="text-align: center;">1986</p> <p>Set a steel fence post, 5½ ft. long, alongside the stainless steel post.</p>	
<p>39.98</p>	<p>S. 89° 54' E., bet. secs. 1 and 12.</p> <p>Over nearly level land, covered with scattered sagebrush, greasewood, shadscale, rabbitbrush and native grass.</p> <p>The ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 12, monumented with a wooden post, 2X3 ins., 26 ins. long, firmly set 12 ins. in the ground, with illegible scribe marks visible, with a steel fence post firmly set alongside and exposed 4 ft. above the ground.</p> <p>At the corner point</p> <p>Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">T38N R68E S 1 ¼ S 12</p> <p style="text-align: center;">1986</p> <p>Reset the original wooden post and the steel fence post, 5½ ft. long, alongside the stainless steel post.</p>	
<p>31.60</p>	<p>N. 81° 48' E., beginning new measurement.</p> <p>Over nearly level land.</p> <p>Intersect the W. bdy. of sec. 6, T. 38 N., R. 69 E.</p> <p>Point for the closing cor. of secs. 1 and 12. This point is identical with a steel fence post, firmly set and exposed 12 ins. above the ground.</p>
