Reestablishment of the Survey Executed by
H. Fitzhugh, U.S. Deputy Surveyor,
in 1894.

The cor. of secs. 3, 4, 33 and 34, monumented with a
wooden post, 2X4 ins., 30 ins. long, with illegible
scribe marks visible, wired to a steel fence post, 5
ft. long, firmly set, and exposed 3 ft. above ground.

At the corner point

Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins.
diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

Reset the original wooden post and steel fence post
alongside the stainless steel post.

Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins.
diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
