At the corner point

Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

Reset the original wooden post and steel fence post and set a steel fence post, 5½ ft. long, alongside the stainless steel post.

From this corner, the cor. of Tps. 39 and 40 N., Rs. 69 E., monumented with a stainless steel post, firmly set and exposed 4 ins. above ground, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the dependent resurvey of T. 39 N., R. 69 E., executed concurrently under this same Group, bears S. 1° 13' W., 14.98 chs. dist.

From this same corner, the W ¼ sec. cor. of sec. 31, T. 40 N., R. 69 E., monumented with a stainless steel post, firmly set and exposed 4 ins. above ground, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the dependent resurvey of T. 40 N., R. 69 E., executed concurrently under Group No. 640, bears N. 1° 13' E., 25.39 chs. dist.

From the cor. of secs. 35 and 36, on the S. bdy. of the Tp., monumented with a stainless steel post, firmly set and exposed 4 ins. above ground, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the dependent resurvey of T. 38 N., R. 68 E., executed concurrently under Group No. 636.

N. 0° 04' W., bet. secs. 35 and 36.

Over gently rolling land, through scattered sagebrush, greasewood and native grass.

The ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 35 and 36, monumented with a wooden post, 2X4 ins., 30 ins. long, firmly set, plainly scribed ¼ on W. face, with a steel fence post, 5 ft. long, alongside.
