42.20	<p>S. 89° 19' E., bet. secs. 13 and 24.</p> <p>Over gently rolling land, through scattered sagebrush, greasewood and native grass.</p> <p>The ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 13 and 24, monumented with a wooden post, 3 ins. square, 30 ins. long, loosely set, plainly scribed ¼ on N. face, with a steel fence post, 5 ft. long, firmly set and exposed 3 ft. above ground, alongside.</p> <p>At the corner point</p> <p>Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.</p> <div style="text-align: center;"> <p>T39N R68E</p> <p> S 13</p> <p>¼ S 24</p> <p>1986</p> </div> <p>Reset the original wooden post and steel fence post alongside the stainless steel post.</p>

This wooden post now becomes an amended monument.
