

TOWNSHIP 41 NORTH, RANGE 68 EAST, MDM, NEVADA

CHAINS

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The land resurveyed within Township 41 North, Range 68 East, ranges in elevation from about 5260 to 5700 ft. above sea level. The terrain is mountainous. The soil is gravelly clay loam to rocky. The timber consists of juniper and pinon pine. The vegetation is made up of sagebrush, cacti, Brigham tea, bitterbrush and native grass.

The township is very mountainous and has many small and varied drainages. Access is limited to a few rough trail roads. The principal users of the area are hunters and ranching. No mineral formations of any consequence were noted during the time of the survey.
