DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF THE WEST BOUNDARY,
T. 38 N., R. 69 E., MOUNT DIABLO MERIDIAN, NEVADA

Reestablishment of the Survey Executed by
J. C. Smyles and C. S. Preble, U. S. Deputy Surveyors,
in 1881, and
the Retracement by H. Fitzhugh, U. S. Deputy Surveyor,
in 1894.

From the cor. of Tps. 37 and 38 N., Rs. 69 E.,
monumented with an iron post, 2½ ins. diam., firmly set
in a mound of stone, with brass cap mkd. as described
in the field notes of the dependent resurvey of T. 37
N., R. 69 E., executed under Group No. 611.

N. 1° 59' W., along the W. bdy. of sec. 31.

Over rolling mountainous land, covered with scattered
juniper, pinon pine, sagebrush, shadscale, bitterbrush
and native grass.

7.42 The closing cor. of Tps. 37 and 38 N., Rs. 68 E.,
monumented with a stainless steel post, 2½ ins. diam.,
firmly set in a mound of stone, with brass cap mkd. as
described in the field notes of T. 38 N., R. 68 E.,
executed concurrently under this same Group.

9.50 Wash, 5 lks. wide, 1 ft. deep, drains ENE.

12.00 Trail road, bears ENE. and WSW.

25.90 Spur, slopes E.

39.37 The W ¼ sec. cor. of sec. 31, monumented with the
decayed remains of a wooden post (record) and a
limestone, 14X7X5 ins., firmly set 7 ins. in the ground
and plainly mkd. ¼ on W. face, with a mound of stone W.

At the corner point

Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins.
diam., 12 ins. in the ground to solid rock and in a
mound of stone, 4 ft. base to top, with brass cap mkd.
