Fitzhugh, U.S. Deputy Surveyor, in 1894.</p> <hr/> <p>From the cor. of Tps. 38 and 39 N., Rs. 69 E., monumented with a stainless steel post, 2½ ins. diam., firmly set and exposed 4 ins. above ground, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the dependent resurvey of T. 38 N., R. 69 E., executed concurrently under Group No. 636.</p> <p>N. 1° 13' W., along the W. bdy. of sec. 31.</p> <p>Over gently rolling land, through scattered sagebrush, greasewood and native grass.</p> <p>16.18 The closing cor. of Tps. 38 and 39 N., Rs. 68 E., monumented with a stainless steel post, 2½ ins. diam., firmly set and exposed 4 ins. above ground, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the dependent resurvey of T. 38 N., R. 68 E., executed concurrently under Group No. 636.</p> <p>33.10 Wash, 20 lks. wide, 3 ft. deep, drains ENE.</p> <p>40.54 Point for the W ¼ sec. cor. of sec. 31, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.</p> <p>Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.</p>
