TOWNSHIP 39 NORTH, RANGE 69 EAST, MDM, NEVADA CHAINS GENERAL DESCRIPTION The land within Township 39 North, Range 69 East, ranges from about 4,800 to 5,200 ft. above sea level, and is nearly level to gently rolling. The soil is sandy clay, gravelly and rocky. The vegetation consists of sagebrush, shadscale, greasewood, rabbitbrush and native grass. The town of Montello is located in sections 17 and 18, and the Southern Pacific Railroad crosses northeasterly through the township, entering on the west boundary of section 19 and leaving on the north boundary of section 2. Nevada State Highway No. 233 roughly parallels the Southern Pacific Railroad. Further access to the township is provided by numerous secondary and desert trail roads. Principal users of the area are small tract homeowners. No mineral formations of consequence were noted during the survey.
