DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF A PORTION OF THE WEST BOUNDARY,
T. 40 N., R. 70 E., MDM, NEVADA

CHAINS

Reset the original wooden post and steel fence post,
alongside the stainless steel post.

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The area resurveyed within Township 40 North, Range 70 East, ranges from about 4,800 to 5,000 ft. above sea level, and is nearly level to gently rolling. The soil is sandy clay, gravely and rocky. The vegetation consists of sagebrush, shadscale, greasewood and native grass.

Principal users of the area are cattlemen and access into the area is provided by improved and unimproved desert trail roads.

No mineral formations of consequence were noted during the survey.
