


DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF A PORTION
OF MINERAL SURVEY NO. 4289,
T. 12 N., R. 68 E., MDM, NEVADA

CHAINS

0.364 The original witness cor. for Cor. No. 3 of M.S. No. 4289, Cave Mine lode, monumented with a wooden post, 4 ins. diam., 30 ins. long, loosely set in a mound of stone, with illegible scribe marks visible.

At the corner point

Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 6 ins. in the ground to solid rock and in a mound of stone, 4 ft. base to top, with brass cap mkd.





Reset the wooden post alongside the stainless steel post.

9.264 The original witness cor. for Cor. No. 4 of M.S. No. 4289, Cave Mine lode, monumented with a cross (X) on bare face of rock, mkd. in large characters WC 4 CAVE 4289.

At the corner point

Set a brass tablet, ¾ ins. diam., ½ ins. stem, in drill hole seated in concrete, with top mkd.

9.612 True point for Cor. No. 4 of M.S. No. 4289, Cave Mine lode, determined at the extension of line 3-4 through the original witness corners of the Cave Mine lode and record distance from the witness cor. of Cor. No. 4 of M.S. No. 4289, Cave Mine lode. This point falls on ledge where a permanent monument cannot be perpetuated.

Thence S. 13° 17' W.

22.744 Cor. No. 1 of the Cave Mine lode, identical with Cor. No. 1 of the Snow Bird Mine lode, both of M.S. No. 4289, hereinbefore described.
