CHAINS

This cor. is located on Highland Ridge, bears N. 28° E. and S. 28° W.

Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 12 ins. in the ground to solid rock and in a mound of stone, 3 ft. base to top, with brass cap mkd.

Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 14 ins. in the ground to solid rock and in a mound of stone, 3 ft. base to top, with brass cap mkd.

SURVEY OF A PORTION OF THE NORTH BOUNDARY,
T. 12 N., R. 68 E., MOUNT DIABLO MERIDIAN, NEVADA

The cor. of secs. 2 and 3, on the N. bdy. of the Tp., is determined EAST of the cor. of Tps. 12 and 13 N., Rs. 67 and 68 E. and at intersection with the second meridional line of T. 12 N., R. 68 E. This point falls on ledge where a permanent monument cannot be perpetuated.

From this point, the point selected for the witness corner of secs. 2 and 3, bears N. 42° 32' W., 0.12 chs. dist.

Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 6 ins. in the ground to solid rock and in a mound of stone, 3 ft. base to top, with brass cap mkd.
