Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 18 ins. in the ground to solid rock and in a mound of stone, 3 ft. base to top, with brass cap mkd.

Reestablishment of a Portion of the Survey Executed by  
J. C. Smyles and C. S. Preble, U.S. Deputy Surveyors,  
in 1881.

From the cor. of secs. 4, 5, 32 and 33, monumented with a stainless steel post, 2½ ins. diam., firmly set and exposed 4 ins. above ground, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the dependent resurvey of T. 40 N., R. 70 E., executed under Group No. 637.

S. 89° 47' E., bet. secs. 4 and 33.

Over rolling land, through scattered sagebrush and native grass.

37.00 Wash, 10 lks. wide, 1 ft. deep, drains NNW.

39.78 Point for the ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 4 and 33, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
