DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF A PORTION OF THE EAST BOUNDARY,
T. 32 N., R. 54 E., MDM, NEVADA

CHAINS

The cor. of secs. 1, 6, 7 and 12, on the E. bdy. of the Tp., monumented with the decayed remains of a wooden post, lying loose on a mound of stone, with illegible scribe marks visible and a steel fence post, 5½ ft. long, firmly set alongside.

At the corner point

Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 16 ins. in the ground to solid rock and in a mound of stone, 3 ft. base to top, with brass cap mkd.

Deposit the decayed remains of the original wooden post and reset the steel fence post alongside the stainless steel post.

N. 0° 36' W., bet. secs. 1 and 6.

Over mountainous land, through scattered sagebrush, native grass and juniper.

- 27.30 Trail road, bears irregularly E. and W.
- 28.60 Left bank of South Fork Humboldt River, bears W. and E.; across water, course W.
- 30.60 Right bank of South Fork Humboldt River, bears W. and E.
- 37.30 Ridge, bears E. and W.
- 40.63 The ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 6, monumented with a limestone, 16X10X6 ins., firmly set in a mound of stone, plainly mkd. ¼ on W. face.

At the corner point

Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 12 ins. in the ground to solid rock and in a mound of stone, 4 ft. base to top, with brass cap mkd.
