40.70	<p>The <math>\frac{1}{4}</math> sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 12, monumented with a limestone, 15X10X6 ins., firmly set in a mound of stone, plainly mkd. <math>\frac{1}{4}</math> on W. face.</p> <p>At the corner point</p> <p>Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, <math>2\frac{1}{2}</math> ins. diam., 16 ins. in the ground to solid rock and in a mound of stone, 3 ft. base to top, with brass cap mkd.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">T32N R54E  <math>\frac{1}{4}</math> <math>\frac{S}{S}</math> <math>\frac{1}{12}</math></p> <p style="text-align: center;">1987</p> <p>Deposit the original cornerstone and set a steel fence post, <math>5\frac{1}{2}</math> ft. long, alongside the stainless steel post.</p> <p>From this corner, a U.S.G.S. Bench Mark, monumented with a standard brass tablet, firmly set in concrete with brass tablet mkd. "11GWM 1951," bears N. <math>39^{\circ} 39'</math> W., 34.53 chs. dist.</p> <hr/> <p>S. <math>89^{\circ} 44'</math> W., beginning new measurement.</p> <p>Over mountainous land.</p>
8.70	Dixie Creek, 10 lks. wide, 1 ft. deep, course NE.
11.00	Trail road, bears NE. and SW.
19.50	Improved gravel road, bears irregularly NNW. and SSE.; enter rolling land.
40.20	<p>The cor. of secs. 1, 2, 11 and 12, monumented with a redwood post, 3 ins. square, 36 ins. long, firmly set 10 ins. in the ground, with illegible scribe marks visible and a steel fence post, <math>5\frac{1}{2}</math> ft. long, firmly set alongside.</p> <p>At the corner point</p> <p>Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, <math>2\frac{1}{2}</math> ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">T32N R54E  <math>\frac{S}{S}</math> <math>\frac{2}{11}</math> <math>\frac{1}{S}</math> <math>\frac{1}{12}</math></p> <p style="text-align: center;">1987</p> <p>Reset the original wooden post and steel fence post, alongside the stainless steel post.</p> <hr/> <p>N. <math>0^{\circ} 24'</math> W., bet. secs. 1 and 2.</p> <p>Over rolling land, through scattered sagebrush, native grass and juniper.</p>
