GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The area resurveyed within Township 32 North, Range 54 East, varies from mountainous in the eastern portion to rolling in the western portion. The elevation ranges from about 5,200 to 5,600 ft. above sea level. The soil is sandy clay loam and rocky on the higher elevations and black loam on the lower elevations. The vegetation consists of shadscale, sagebrush and native grass. There are scattered stands of juniper on the southeast corner of the area with willows along the South Fork Humboldt River, which drains the area from S. to N.

Principal users of the area are cattlemen and access into the township is provided by improved and unimproved roads. No mineral formations of consequence were noted during the survey.
