CHAINS

The cor. of Tps. 33 N., Rs. 54 and 55 E., monumented with a volcanic stone, 36X18X12 ins., loosely set in a mound of stone, plainly mkd. with 6 notches on the N. and W. edges.

At the corner point

Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long,  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ins. diam., 16 ins. in the ground to solid rock and in a mound of stone, 4 ft. base to top, with brass cap mkd.
