	GENERAL DESCRIPTION
	The area resurveyed within Township 33 North, Range 54 East, is mostly mountainous to rolling mountainous land with rolling land in the southern portion. The elevation ranges from about 4,900 to 5,800 ft. above sea level. The soil varies from sandy clay load and rocky on the higher elevations to black loam on the bottom land. The vegetation consists of sagebrush, shadscale, rabbitbrush and native grass. There are heavy stands of juniper and pinon pine throughout the township with scattered stands of willow along the South Fork Humboldt River which crosses the township from S. to N.
	Principal users of the area are cattlemen and access into the township is provided by improved and unimproved roads. No mineral formations of consequence were noted during the survey.
