CHAINS

Reestablishment of the Survey Executed by
G. W. Garside, U.S. Deputy Surveyor in 1879
and
the Resurvey Executed by
U.S. Cadastral Engineer C. S. Swanholm and U.S.
Surveyor W. H. Good
in 1927 - 1929.

The $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 35, monumented with a 1 in.
diam. iron post, firmly set flush with the ground, with
brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the
dependent resurvey of T. 44 N., R. 25 E., executed
under Group No. 122. Remark the brass cap to read as
follows:

Rebuild the mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, N.
of cor.

N. $85^{\circ} 40'$ W., along the S. bdy. of sec. 35.

Over rolling mountainous land, through scattered
sagebrush and bunchgrass.

0.20 Virgin Creek, 10 lks. wide, 1 ft. deep, course NNE.

2.80 Top of ledge on W. side of Virgin Creek.

13.11 The cor. of secs. 3 and 4, T. 44 N., R. 25 E.,
monumented with an iron post, 2 ins. diam., firmly set
in a mound of stone, showing 8 ins. above ground, with
a mound of stone S., with brass cap mkd. as described
in the field notes of the dependent resurvey of T. 44
N., R. 25 E., executed under Group No. 122. Add 1988
to the brass cap.

N. $85^{\circ} 31'$ W., beginning new measurement.

Over rolling land.

28.07 The cor. of secs. 34 and 35, monumented with an iron
post, 2 ins. diam., firmly set showing 8 ins. above
ground, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field
notes of the dependent resurvey of T. 44 N., R. 25 E.,
executed under Group No. 122. Add 1988 to the brass
cap.
