The soil is sandy clay loam to rocky in the higher elevations. The vegetation consists of sagebrush and bunchgrass in the higher elevations with meadowland in the bottom land. Virgin Creek crosses the area in a northeasterly direction. Wilson's ranch house is located in the NW ¼ of sec. 25, there is a trailer court in the SW ¼ NE ¼ sec. 25.</div> <div>The area is used by ranchers for cattle grazing.</div> <div>There are mineral formations throughout the area where opal is mined.</div> | |
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
