Raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, SE. of cor.


Thence S. 81° 59' 32" E.

5.499 Cor. No. 4 of M.S. No. 57 B, Sterling Millsite, monumented with a mound of earth.

At the corner point

Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

Raise a mound of stone, f 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, SW. of cor.

Thence S. 7° 59' 52" W.

8.999 Cor. No. 1 of M.S. No. 57 B, Sterling Millsite and place of beginning.

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The area surveyed and resurveyed within Township 5 South, Range 55½ East, ranges from about 6,400 to 7,800 ft. above sea level and is mountainous. The soil consists of rocky clay loam. The vegetation consists of sagebrush, Brigham tea, cacti, rabbitbrush and native grass.

There are dense stands of juniper and pinon pine throughout the township with scattered mountain mahogany in the northern area.

Access into the township is limited to a few unimproved trail roads.

No mineral formations of consequence were noted during the survey.
