Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 16 ins. in the ground to solid rock and in a mound of stone, 3 ft. base to top, with brass cap mkd.

The angle point bet. sec. 16, T. 5 S., R. 55½ E. and sec. 19, T. 5 S., R. 56 E., monumented with a stainless steel post, 2½ ins. diam., firmly set exposed 4 ins. above the ground, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the survey of T. 5 S., R. 55½ E., executed concurrently under this same Group, bears S. 1° 43' E., 5.03 chs. dist.

The angle point bet. sec. 9, T. 5 S., R. 55½ E. and sec. 18, T. 5 S., R. 56 E., monumented with a stainless steel post, 2½ ins. diam., firmly set in a mound of stone, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the survey of T. 5 S., R. 55½ E., executed concurrently under this same Group, bears N. 1° 43' W., 34.44 chs. dist.
