The land is rolling with sandy clay loam and rocky soil. The vegetation consists of Brigham tea, greasewood and native grasses. There are scattered Joshua trees throughout the township.</p> <p>Access into the township is provided by improved gravel and trail roads.</p> <p>No mineral formations of consequence were noted during the survey.</p> <p>Principal users of the area are cattlemen.</p> <hr/>
