	<p>GENERAL DESCRIPTION</p> <p>The lines resurveyed in Township 18 North, Range 66 East, ranges in elevation from about 5,600 ft. to 5,800 ft. above sea level. The terrain is rolling with pasture land along the eastern edge. The soil is sandy clay loam with gravel. The vegetation consists of rabbitbrush, shadscale, sagebrush and native grass.</p> <p>The township drains generally east. Access is provided by Nevada State Highway No. 893, which runs in a general north and south direction on the east side of the township. There are numerous trail roads joining into the paved road.</p> <p>No mineral formations of any consequence were noted during the course of the resurvey.</p>
