

TOWNSHIP 17 NORTH, RANGE 67 EAST, MDM, NEVADA

CHAINS

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The land resurveyed within Township 17 North, Range 67 East, ranges in elevation from about 5,500 to 5,800 ft. above sea level. The terrain is mostly level except for some hummocks and the western part which is at the foot of the mountain range. The soil varies from alkali bottoms to sandy clay loam with gravel. The vegetation consists of rabbitbrush, sagebrush, greasewood, halogeton and native grass with some scattered juniper in the extreme southwest portion.

The township drains from the east and west sides into the middle of the township where Yelland Dry Lake is full of water. Access is very limited with Nevada State Highway No. 893 along the west boundary and an improved gravel road along the south boundary with a limited number of trail roads.

No mineral formations of any consequence were noted during the course of the resurvey.
