brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the
independent resurvey of T. 17 S., R. 65 E., executed
under Group NO. 373.

N. $0^{\circ} 02.2'$ W., bet. secs. 7 and 12.

Over rolling land, covered with scattered chaparral,
creosote and cacti.

19.891 Intersect the Fourth Standard Parallel South.

Point for the closing cor. of Tps. 17 S., Rs. 65 and
66. E.

Set an aluminum post, 30 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 24
ins. in the ground, with aluminum cap mkd.

 $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., firmly set showing 6 ins. above ground,
with aluminum cap mkd. as described in the field notes
of the dependent resurvey of T. 16 S., R. 65 E.,
executed concurrently under this same Group, bears N.
 $86^{\circ} 40.6'$ E., 9.617 chs. dist.

From this same corner, the closing cor. of Tps. 17 S.,
Rs. 65 and 66 E., monumented with an iron post, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins.
diam., firmly set showing 6 ins. above ground, with
brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the
independent resurvey of T. 17 S., R. 65 E., executed
under Group No. 373, bears N. $0^{\circ} 02.2'$ W., 9.530 chs.
dist. Hereafter, this cor. will function as an amended
monument.
