1.99	<p>Ridge, bears N. 50° E. and S. 50° W.</p>
14.263	<p>An original line tree, a western white pine (Record, fir), 36 ins. diam., in good condition, mkd. with 2 healed line blaze notches on both N. and S. sides.</p> <hr/>
	<p>N. 0° 01.3' W., beginning new measurement.</p>
23.84	<p>Rocky ridge, slopes S. 65° W.</p>
25.878	<p>The cor. of Tps. 16 and 17 N., Rs. 18 and 19 E., monumented with an iron post, 3 ins. diam., firmly set, projecting 10 ins. above an embedded mound of stone, 3 ft. diam., found remnants of original post lying loose on top of mound, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the 1935-45 dependent resurvey of the S. bdy. of T. 17 N., R. 19 E., executed under Group Nos. 156 and 332, from which the remains of the 1861 bearing trees</p>
	<p>A pine snag, 15 ft. tall, broken top, 12 ins. diam., bears N. 27° 00' E., 50½ lks. dist., with faded marks T17N 19E S31 BT and chaining notch visible. (Record, N. 24° 15' E., 51 lks.)</p>
	<p>A whitebark pine, 19 ins. diam., bears S. 36° 45' E., 41½ lks. dist., with the marks BT visible in nearly healed blaze. (1861 Record, S. 36° 15' E., 38 lks.) (1935 Record, S. 36° 15' E., 46 lks.)</p>
	<p>A pine, dead, down, and decayed, 22 ins. diam., bears S. 47° 15' W., 143½ lks. dist., with the marks T16N R18E S1 BT and chaining notch visible. (Record, S. 48° W., 14 lks.)</p>
	<p>A pine snag, 24 ins. diam., bears N. 23° 30' W., 54 lks. dist., with the marks T17N R18E S36 BT and chaining notch visible. (1861 Record, N. 24° 15' W., 55 lks.) (1935 Record, 63 lks.)</p>
	<p>and the 1935 bearing trees</p>
	<p>A whitebark pine, 14 ins. diam., bears N. 47° 15' E., 92 ½ lks. dist., with the marks 19 R17E S31 BT visible in partially healed blaze. (Record, N. 47° 30' E., 95 lks.)</p>
