

DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF A PORTION OF THE SUBDIVISIONAL LINES,
TOWNSHIP 16 NORTH, RANGE 19 EAST, MDM, NEVADA

CHAINS

The cor. of secs. 5, 6, 31 and 32, on the N. bdy. of the Tp., monumented with an iron post, 2 ins. diam., firmly set, projecting 12 ins. above an embedded mound of stone, 3 ft. diam., with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the 1935-45 dependent resurvey of the S. bdy. of T. 17 N., R. 19 E., executed under Group Nos. 156 and 332, from which the 1935 bearing trees

A western white pine, 13 ins. diam., bears N. $48^{\circ} 15'$ E., 24 lks. dist., with a healed blaze. (Record, 25 lks.)

A mountain hemlock, 14 ins. diam., bears S. $80^{\circ} 15'$ E., 10 lks. dist., with the marks 16N 19E S5 BT visible in partially healed blaze. (Record, S. $77\frac{3}{4}^{\circ}$ E.)

A mountain hemlock, 11 ins. diam., bears S. $63^{\circ} 15'$ W., $52\frac{1}{2}$ lks. dist., with the marks T16 R1 S BT visible in partially healed blaze. (Record, S. $66\frac{3}{4}^{\circ}$ W., 53 lks.)

A western white pine, 17 ins. diam., bears N. $16^{\circ} 15'$ W., 62 lks. dist., with a healed blaze. (Record, hemlock, N. $15\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}$ W., 61 lks.)

Add the marks 1988 to the brass cap.

From this corner, U.S.G.S. Triangulation Station "PRICE", bears S. $65^{\circ} 50.5'$ W., 22.361 chs. dist., monumented with a standard brass tablet, 3 ins. diam., with cap mkd. PRICE 1949 and a triangle. Reference marks 1 and 2 were recovered in good condition.

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

Township 16 North, Range 19 East, is located in southern Washoe County and northern Carson City County, Nevada, 3 miles northwest of Carson City and 2 air miles east of Lake Tahoe. The small city of Franktown is situated in the north $\frac{1}{2}$ of section 10. The Carson Mountain Range comprises the entire west half of the Tp., with the main ridge trending northerly along the west boundary of the Tp. The divide reaches 9,085 feet above sea level at Roger's Peak in the western portion of section 6 to the lowest portion of the Tp. at Washoe Lake along the easterly boundary, with an elevation of 5,025 feet above sea level.
