

TOWNSHIP 11 NORTH, RANGE 68 EAST, MDM, NEVADA

<p>CHAINS</p>	<p>GENERAL DESCRIPTION</p> <p>The area surveyed within Township 11 North, Range 68 East, ranges from about 8,900 to 10,300 ft. above sea level, and is mountainous.</p> <p>The soil consists of sandy clay loam and rocky. Vegetation consists of sagebrush, buckbrush, mahogany and native grass. There is Bristle cone pine, limber pine and aspen throughout the township.</p> <p>The area is drained by Decathon Canyon, Johns Wash and Murphy Wash, which drains southerly.</p> <p>Access into the area is limited to a hiking trail from Lehman Caves National Monument.</p> <p>Principal users of the area are cattlemen.</p> <p>There were no mineral formations of consequence noted during this survey.</p>
