	<p>78.40 Decathon Canyon trail road, bears N. and S.</p> <p>82.39 The cor. of secs. 18 and 19, on the W. bdy. of the Tp. NORTH, 13.0 lks. from the tangent, hereinbefore described.</p> <p>Land, mountainous. Soil, sandy clay loam and rocky. Undergrowth, sagebrush, buckbrush, mahogany and native grass. Timber, Bristlecone pine, limber pine and ponderosa pine.</p> <hr/> <p>GENERAL DESCRIPTION</p> <p>The area surveyed and resurveyed within Township 11 North, Range 69 East, ranges from about 7,800 to 10,300 ft. above sea level and is mountainous.</p> <p>The soil consists of sandy clay loam and rocky. Vegetation consists of sagebrush, buckbrush, mahogany and native grass. There are Bristlecone pine, limber pine, and aspen throughout the township.</p> <p>The area is drained by Lexington Creek, which drains easterly and Big Spring Wash, which drains southerly.</p> <p>Access into the township is limited to a few trail roads.</p> <p>Principal users of the area are cattlemen and sheepherders.</p> <p>There is some mining activity located in sec. 3.</p>
