

TOWNSHIP 12 NORTH, RANGE 69 EAST, MDM, NEVADA

CHAINS

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The area surveyed and resurveyed within Township 12 North, Range 69 East, ranges from about 6,700 to 8,100 ft. above sea level, and is mountainous.

The soil consists of sandy clay loam and rocky to black loam along Snake Creek. Vegetation consists of sagebrush, buckbrush and native grass. There is juniper, pinon pine and mahogany throughout the township with scattered stands of cottonwood along the creeks.

The area is drained by Lexington Creek, Big Wash and Snake Creek, which flows easterly.

Access into the area is provided by improved gravel roads.

Principal users of the area are cattlemen.

There were no mineral formations of consequence noted during this survey.
