20.10	Ridge, bears E. and W.
35.60	Ravine, drains ENE.
38.10	Trail road, bears ENE. and WSW.
39.64	The W ¼ sec. cor. of sec. 2, monumented with an iron post, 2½ ins. diam., firmly set and exposed 10 ins. above ground, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the dependent resurvey of T. 13 N., R. 69 E., executed under Group No. 503. Add the marks 1987 to the brass cap.
