TOWNSHIP 13 NORTH, RANGE 69 EAST, MDM, NEVADA CHAINS **GENERAL DESCRIPTION** The area surveyed within Township 13 North, Range 69 East, ranges from about 6,400 to 7,880 ft. above sea level, and is mostly mountainous to rolling. The soil is sandy clay loam and rocky, the vegetation consists of sagebrush, buckbrush and native grass. There are stands of juniper, pinon pine, mahogany and some cottonwood throughout the township. The area is drained by Lehman Creek and Baker Creek, which flows easterly. Access into the area is provided by State Route No. 488 and numerous improved and unimproved roads. Principal users of the area are cattlemen. There were no mineral formations of consequence noted during the survey.
