	CHAINS	<p>Raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, W. of cor.</p> <p>5.70 Snake Creek, 10 lks. wide, 1 ft. deep, course ENE.</p> <p>11.50 Snake Creek - Garrison road, improved gravel, bears E. and W.</p> <p>39.96 The cor. of secs. 7, 8, 17 and 18, monumented with an iron post, 2 ins. diam., firmly set in a mound of stone, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the survey of T. 12 N., R. 70 E., executed under Group No. 71, from which the remaining original bearing trees</p> <p>A pinon pine, 8 ins. diam., bears S. $5\frac{3}{4}^{\circ}$ W., 22 lks. dist., with illegible scribe marks visible. (Record, S. 5° W., 27 lks. dist.)</p> <p>A pinon pine, 6 ins. diam., bears N. $56\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}$ W., 23 lks. dist., with illegible scribe marks visible.</p> <p>Add the marks 1988 to the brass cap.</p> <hr/> <p>SURVEY OF A TRAVERSE OF THE SOUTH BANK OF SNAKE CREEK, THROUGH SECTION 18, T. 12 N., R. 70 E., MOUNT DIABLO MERIDIAN, NEVADA</p> <hr/> <p>From the witness point bet. secs. 13 and 18, on the W. bdy. of the Tp., monumented with a stainless steel post, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., firmly set and exposed 4 ins. above the ground, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the dependent resurvey of T. 12 N., R. 69 E., executed concurrently under this same Group.</p> <p>S. $82^{\circ} 06'$ E., along the traverse through sec. 18.</p> <p>Over rolling land, along Snake Creek.</p> <p>12.63 Angle Point No. 1, established on the right bank of Snake Creek to define the sinuosities of Snake Creek.</p> <p>Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 18 ins. in the ground to solid rock and in a mound of stone, 3 ft. base to top, with brass cap mkd.</p> <p>T12N R70E S 18  AP 1 1988</p> <hr/> <p>S. $68^{\circ} 48'$ E., on line 1-2, along the traverse through sec. 18.</p> <p>Over rolling land, along Snake Creek.</p>
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
